### WHAT IS MEN'S FRATERNITY?

Men's Fraternity is a series of three studies, beginning with *The Quest for Authentic Manhood*, followed by *Authentic Manhood: Winning at Work and Home*, and concluding with *The Great Adventure* series. More than just a rally or a Bible study, Men's Fraternity provides men with an encouraging process that teaches them how to live lives of authentic manhood as modeled by Jesus Christ and directed by the Word of God.

Men's Fraternity was designed to help men come together and strengthen each other through weekly sessions that combine biblical teaching and small group interaction.

### THE FORMAT

Men's Fraternity is a series of two 12-week sessions offered yearly. Men begin with *The Quest for Authentic Manhood* sessions in the first year; moving to *Winning at Work and Home* in the second year.

The format is simple: Men come together for weekly 45-minute teaching sessions, followed by 30 minutes of small group interaction in an environment where men are free to talk openly and confidentially about what they heard and express mutual support for one another.
